

2019 PARADE PARTICIPANTS - Parade Day Instructions

All entries **must be in the staging area no later than 5:00 pm** on July 19, 2019.

The Parade will begin promptly at 6:00 pm.

Staging area will be blocked off to through traffic after 3:30 pm on Friday July 19.

Parade Officials will be there to assist you and give directions.

Staging Instructions

- Place identifying number you will receive from Parade Officials on your entry prior to the parade.
- Participants should bring their own water.
- Make sure your entry is in your assigned space. Your staging position is marked on the street and is indicated on the map. If you have any questions, contact a Parade Official.
- Make sure all entry participants know their entry number.
- It is critical that you enter the staging area from the right direction. There is no turnaround space. Large entries are advised to come early to assure ease in getting into position. (Big floats and larger trailers should arrive by 4:30 pm).
- Entrants who are lining up on 200 West and Main Street should enter off on Hwy 106 (400 West) at 1800 South. Parade Officials will be there to help you.
- Entrants must be in position by 5:00 pm so the parade starts on time! If you miss your entry spot, you will be shifted to the end of the parade.
- Review your Parade Rules & Requirements. Violations could cause your entry to be pulled.
- Handing out candy requires prior approval by the Handcart Days Committee. Do not begin distribution of wrapped candy until you are on Main Street headed north, please pass the roundabout at 1500 South. **Do not throw anything from any Parade Entry, including bikes, floats, cars, etc. Provide persons walking at the curb to distribute candy, hand to hand. We do not want children running out into the street to get candy. Do not distribute candy after turning west on 400 N. (This is a State Highway and under State Law distribution of any kind is unlawful.) Distribution of other promotional items must be done ON THE SIDEWALK only.**
- All entries must keep moving and maintain spacing between other entries. No stopping for routines, or to refill candy supplies, etc. You must maintain a 35 foot space between you and the entry in front of you. Parade escorts will accompany your entry to help maintain the appropriate space. Please respond to officials request to speed up or slow down to fill any gaps.
- The parade starts at 1500 South and Main Street then proceeds north along Main street to 400 North then west on 400 N. to 100 W. then south on 100 W. **DO NOT STOP** after making the turn onto 100 West, proceed further on 100 west to your designated disbandment area as directed by disbandment volunteers. Parade Officials will instruct you where to turn to exit the parade area. .
- **BANDS:** Buses should exit from I-15 at the Woods Cross (2600 South) and proceed east to Orchard Dr. (400 E) then north to 1500 S and turn left (west) on 1500 S. Go west to 50 West in front of Bountiful Elementary School where band members and equipment will be unloaded. Band members will find their band entry number on the North side of 1500 South above the roundabout at Main Street.
- **Empty buses** will proceed to Meadow Brook Elementary located at 325 West 700 north where Band members will meet after the parade.
- **Floats and General Entries:** Go to 1800 South and take either Main Street or 200 West and locate your entry number which will be displayed on the street. Parade Officials will be available to assist you.

- **VIP Entries & Emergency Service Vehicles (ESV):** Proceed North on Hwy 106 from 1800 So. Turn right onto 1500 South to the VIP staging area on the West side of 1500 South Renaissance Drive. ESV staging area is on the North of 1500 So.
- **Horse Entries:** will stage in the rear parking area behind Wells Fargo Bank on the north side of 1500 So. Please provide protection if you are able. Pooper scoopers will be provided.
- **Primary Children:** will meet at the tennis courts near Bountiful Elementary (1620 S. 50 W.). Primary children must have their entry number attached to their clothing to help you assemble them. Bring water and any treats you desire. Restrooms are available in the park. Make sure parents understand where to meet their children after the parade. **Never leave children unattended.**

Disbanding Instructions:

- Parade entries will continue south on 100 West toward Center Street then turn west on 200 North, 100 North or Center Street as directed by Parade officials to leave the parade area or proceed on 100 West to 500 South as directed by Parade officials and leave the parade area there.
- Do not plan to meet your family members who are in the parade on 100 W. north of Center St. because other parade entries will be using 100 W. as they exit the parade. (except Primary Children)
- Primary Children will be unloaded on 100 West and 200 North at the State Farm Insurance Building. Parents should plan to meet and pick up their children there.
- All entries with youth must not unload on 100 West, but should proceed as directed by parade officials and unload down 300 North, 100 North, or beyond Center Street. All parent pick-up must be conducted on these side roads.
- Horse and clown entries use 100 West to 200 North, turn west on 200 North, then disband in the LDS Church parking lot located at 200 North 200 West.

We appreciate your participation in the parade and for following these guidelines. We hope you enjoy your experience in our Handcart Days Grand Parade.

If it is not possible for your entry to be in the parade, please notify us as soon as possible.
