

2018 PARADE ENTRY RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

Parade participants must comply with all parade rules and instructions given to them by parade officials. Failure to comply with parade rules will result in the entry being immediately removed from the parade.

The Bountiful Handcart Days Committee retains the right to change these rules at any time deemed necessary to conform to the intent and guidelines set forth by the Board of Trustees.

1. Entry applications will not be accepted when Bountiful Handcart Days determines an entry to be controversial, unlawful, or inconsistent with the standards, the theme and the purposes of the Bountiful Handcart Days parade. At any time after acceptance an entry may not be allowed to participate in the parade if it deviates from the original application or violates any parade rule.
2. Registration is open March 1 to June 1, 2018 or until 95 entries are received. Entries are open on a first come basis. An entry fee of \$150.00 must accompany each application. No entry will be registered until fee is paid. (Late entry fee \$300.00 for any fee received after June 1, 2018.) The parade committee may waive entry fees for special circumstances. Entry fees will be returned if an application is not accepted by the parade committee.
3. Vehicle entries with VIP, mascots etc. will be allowed in the parade if prior approval is granted by the parade committee. All entries must be decorated and Theme Related.
4. Decorated entries broadcasting music will be permitted when requested on the application and approved by the parade committee. Marching groups are strongly encouraged to be accompanied by live music.
5. Reasonable discretion should be taken concerning the number of individuals permitted to ride on any entry. Clowns or other individuals will be allowed to walk beside an entry with prior approval.

6. Bountiful Handcart Days encourages self-propelled floats. All entries should be decorated and theme related. If a float is pulled by a vehicle it must also be decorated to conform to the theme. Drivers must remain with entry vehicle.
7. All entries must be capable of maneuvering around sharp turns and must clear all overhead obstacles. Maximum entry size requirements are as follows: Height=14 feet, Width=15 feet, **Length=65 feet. (This includes the length of the truck/trailer combined.)**
8. The name of a sponsor attached to an entry must be in a form and size acceptable to the parade committee. No other printed material except entry theme, parade number and name of sponsor may be attached to a parade entry.
9. Antique vehicles should have a sign indicating the year and make of the vehicle.
10. VIP entries are by invitation only and cars carrying VIPs shall have signs that conform to parade committee guidelines. Absolutely no political campaigning is allowed.
11. Local schools will be limited to two entries, one of which may be a band. No ATVs or water spraying allowed. No items can be thrown from any entry.
12. All participants will conduct themselves and operate their vehicles and parade apparatus in a safe manner at all times.
13. A sketch or picture and a complete description of the entry MUST be included with the application form and entry fee.
14. All entries are to be made available to Bountiful Handcart Days representatives for inspection at reasonable times.
15. As a condition of participation, participants agree that Bountiful Handcart Days does not assume responsibility for any injury or harm and agrees to indemnify Bountiful Handcart Days, its officers, volunteers and agents from

any and all claims, liabilities, damages and losses arising, directly or indirectly, out of Participant's involvement in the parade.

16. Walking participants should be at least 10 years old or accompanied by an adult, and be able to walk two miles in temperatures over 90 degrees. Walking youth groups must have one adult for every 10 youth participants. Young children walk too slow and hold up the parade.
17. No unauthorized entry will be allowed on the parade route.
18. Parade officials walking along the parade route will assist entries to maintain proper spacing. Entries are required to follow directions given by these officials. Entries that fail to follow this rule may be removed from the parade.
19. It is required that entries provide drinking water for their participants use prior to and during the parade.
20. The following guidelines for fashion wear of parade participants must be adhered to: No two-piece swim suit, bikini, one piece swim suit with "French Cut" legs, "Speedo" (or similar), or weight lifting exhibition wear may be worn without a one-piece cover-up. The cover-up cannot be mesh or sheer fabric. It must be tied, buttoned or somehow closed at the waist and must hang approximately mid-thigh. No bare chests for males or females.
21. No motorcycles, three wheelers, four wheelers, bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or in-line skates are permitted unless requested on application and approved by the parade committee.
22. No water spraying allowed.
23. Bountiful City ordinances do not prohibit parade participants from distributing items including candy along the parade route. However for the safety of parade spectators, participants walking along the side of their entry can distribute items. **No throwing of anything from vehicles or floats is allowed.**
24. We do not want children running out into the street to get candy, so only give it to children who stay off the street. Nothing can be distributed on 400

North. When items or candy will be distributed to the spectators it must be indicated on the parade application form.

25. The parade will consist of 85 to 100 entries.

26. The deadline for parade entries is June 1, 2018 or when 95 entries is reached.
