

2020 Parade Day Instructions – All Parade Participants

All Parade entries must be in their staging area no later than 5:00 pm. Parade Day!

Barricades will be at the following locations; 1100 South & 300 West, 1500 South & Highway 68, Main Street & 1800 South, and 200 West & 1800 South, in Bountiful. You will not be able to travel on any roads that have barricades. Main Street will be closed to through traffic after 3:30 pm. on Friday July 17th: Parade officials will be available to assist you and give directions once you arrive at the general staging area.

STAGING INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Check website** (see www.handcartdays.org, Events, Parade, Staging) for entry line up information and map indicating your location assignment, and entry number.
- *Participants should bring their own water*
- Make sure your entry is in space assigned to you. Your staging assignment is marked on the map, if you have questions please contact a parade official.
- All Parade entries should know their entry number prior to assembly – (see www.handcartdays.org, Events, Parade, Staging) **Please place identifying number on left front corner of your entry, prior to the Parade.**
- Entries lining up on Main Street or 200 West should be coming from the south, heading in a northerly direction.
- It is critical that *Parade Entries come into the staging area correctly in order to insure proper line up.* There is no turnaround space; large entries are advised to come early to assure ease in getting into position. (Large floats and trailers should arrive by 4:30)
- Review your Parade Rules & Regulations; please initial with a parade official at line up.
- Once the Parade starts, ALL entries must keep moving and maintain spacing between other entries as directed. No stopping for any reason. There should be a 35 foot space between you and the entry in front of you. Parade escorts will help to maintain proper spacing along parade route. *Please follow their instructions* to slow down or speed up as necessary.
- The parade route starts at 1500 South & Main Street, Bountiful, proceeding NORTH to 400 North, then turns Left on (SR106) 400 North, to 100 West. At 400 North and 100 West, entries turn Left again, **DO NOT STOP** here! Continue south on 100 west to your designated disbandment area as directed by parade officials.

BANDS

- Buses should exit from I-15 at the Woods Cross exit (2600 South) and proceed to stop light at Highway 89 where a Left turn is made. Continue north taking the right fork at HWY 68 (400 West) to 1875 South. *Proceed east to 50 West where you will be directed by parade officials*
- Empty buses will proceed to Meadow Brook Elementary, located at 325 West 700 North where Band members meet following the parade.

FLOATS & GENERAL ENTRIES

- As you arrive in general staging area, you will be directed by parade officials to your specific area.

VIP Entries & Emergency Service Vehicles (ESV)

- Arrive in general staging area where you will be directed by parade officials to specific location.

HORSE ENTRIES – (only exception)

- Proceed to 1500 South at 300 West. You will be directed to the north side of 1500 South (zone 4) (Behind Wells Fargo Bank) Meet with parade official there who will radio officials so that we know you have arrived. Please provide protection if you are able, then move trailers to church parking lot at 200 North 250 West, your horses will meet you there. Pooper scoopers will be provided.

PRIMARY CHILDREN

- Parade officials will direct you upon arrival. Children will gather at park (1620 S. 50 West) Children should have their entry # attached to clothing. Bring water and snacks as needed. Restrooms are available in park. Chaperones/parents should remain with children. There is no parking available. Please do not plan to drive your children to drop off. You may park elsewhere and walk your child to park.

DISBANDING INSTRUCTIONS

- Parade entries will continue south on 100 West toward Center Street then turn west at 300 North, 200 North and 100 North **as directed by parade officials** to leave the parade area or proceed on 100 West to 500 South as directed to leave the parade area.
- Do not plan to meet family members who in the parade on 100 West, north of Center Street!! Other parade entries will be using 100 west to exit the parade (except primary children).
- Primary children will be unloaded on 100 West and 200 North at the State Farm Insurance building. Parents should plan to meet and pick up their children at this designated area.
- **All entries with youth should not unload on 100 West**, but should proceed *as directed by parade officials and unload down 300, 200, or 100 North or beyond Center Street.* All parent pick up must be done along these side roads.
- Horse entries use 100 West to 200 North, turn west on 200 North and disband at the church building parking lot located at 200 North 250 West, where horse trailers are parked.

**If it is not possible for your entry to be in the parade on July 17th,
Please notify us as soon as possible.**

We appreciate your participation in the 'Handcart Days Parade'. We expect that you will comply with these posted instructions, as well as follow any and all direction given to you by Parade officials.
